AROMI COLLECTION

The **Aromi** collection is the line of fabrics proposed by CTA®, inspired by the use of colours, textures and patterns, by natural aromas.

It is not uncommon for collections of this type to be created to evoke authentic and elegant atmospheres, characterized by warm tones and material and natural textures.

Aromi adds to the variety of articles present in the CTA® collection, a range of products characterized mainly by natural fibers, such as linen and cotton, finished with specific treatments that the fabrics undergo after weaving to improve their characteristics, such as softness, resistance and the aesthetic aspect.

The collection is composed of 8 items:





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CUBEBE



Cubebe is a decorative knitted fabric, characterized by the use of thicker threads than traditional yarns. It is known for its material texture and for its softness and versatility.

This type of fabric is particularly suitable for creating modern and informal environments.

It takes its name from a spice known as cubebe pepper, which is used in some culinary traditions and perfumery for its characteristic aroma.

Made of 96% PL 4% CO, it is available in width 300/305 cm.

The color range includes 20 intense color nuances.

CUMINO



Cumin is a spice that belongs to the Apiaceae family, and is known for its warm, earthy and slightly spicy aroma.

The **Cumino** fabric is a tightly woven linen hemp, versatile and resistant, with a rough and raw structure; this feature gives it a natural and rustic appearance.

Ideal as decoration and curtains, in 70% PL 30% LI.

Available in 315/320 cm, proposed in 4 nuances: white, natural, sand and linen.



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CURCUMA



Turmeric, famous for its intense golden yellow colour, has been used for centuries to dye natural fibers such as wool, linen and cotton.

It is one of the most common spices used in natural dyeing, thanks to its intense coloring.

Its use in fabrics has a long tradition, especially in India.

Curcuma is a flame linen curtain, made of 80% PL 20% LI, soft to the touch, characterized by a weave of warp and weft, which animates the fabric, giving it a slightly irregular yet fascinating and texture-rich appearance.

It is available in width 315/320 cm in the same color nuances as the Cumino article.

CURRY



The **Curry** fabric recalls the rich and warm aroma, typical of India.

Curtain made with linen fiber and woven with a twill structure.

The main feature is the particular arrangement of the threads, which create a diagonal pattern and a more resistant texture, giving freshness and breathability to the linen.

Curtain in 59% LI 41% PL, available in width 310/315 cm.

The palette is made up of 14 colors that recall the natural tones of the earth, such as brown, beige, green, brick and ocher. These colors bring back a warm and welcoming atmosphere as if to evoke a sense of comfort and connection with nature.



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MACIS



Macis is a type of fabric that takes its name from the term Mace, its covering is pinkish-orange, and is found around nutmeg seeds.

A mix linen and cotton sablé, constructed with a thin metallic yarn. Its matte and shiny effect and its soft texture contribute to an elegant and welcoming atmosphere. It has a slightly irregular surface which gives it a sophisticated and luxurious look.

The melange of the linen yarn gives the surface a mottled appearance. It is made of 51% PL 26% CO 12% LI 11% VI.

Macis is available in width 305/310 cm, in 17 pastel color variations.

PAPRIKA



Paprika is a spice obtained from sweet or hot peppers, which are dried and ground. Its enveloping but at the same time pleasantly fruity taste transmits constant energy.

The **Paprika** curtain is a flocked print with a white pigment, to create depth and three-dimensionality to the product.

The proposed curtain is in 50% PL 28% LI 22% VI, and is available in 295/300 cm with lead finish, two color options, in neutral and delicate palettes.



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SUMAC



Sumac, known for its spicy flavour, is used in cooking, but its properties can also be used to dye fabrics, thanks to its pigment content.

Sumac, an all-over embroidery with an ethnic trend proposed by CTA®, is made on a 100% PL background, available in two color variations: natural and ecru in 305/310 cm with a lead finish. With a drooping and fluid feel, it is suitable for curtain use.

TIMUT



Timut is a type of curtain in 70% PL 30% LI, which takes its name from a variety of pepper originating from the Himalayas, inspired by the aromatic, exotic and sophisticated notes of the spice.

It is a light gauze, with a less flamed texture than common linen, on which a finishing has been carried out which gives the product an unusual softness.

Available in width 315/320 cm, proposed in 21 color nuances that reflect the natural colors and the darker and burnt ones of the earth.
